

Kawazu Tourist Information Map

※ It is not possible to walk between Kawazu Station and Nana-daru, since the distance is 10 kilometer slope road. Bus service operated by Tokai Bus is available. It takes about 30 minutes (costs about 600 yen).



Kawazu is often used as a filming location for movies and soap operas.

The short story, "The Izu Dancer" which was authored by the first Japanese Nobel Prize winner, Yasunari Kawabata has been dramatized in 6 movies in Japan.

It is a story about an early love between a young male student and one of the traveling dance performers. The Yugano area in Kawazu was used as a filming location for the movie.
